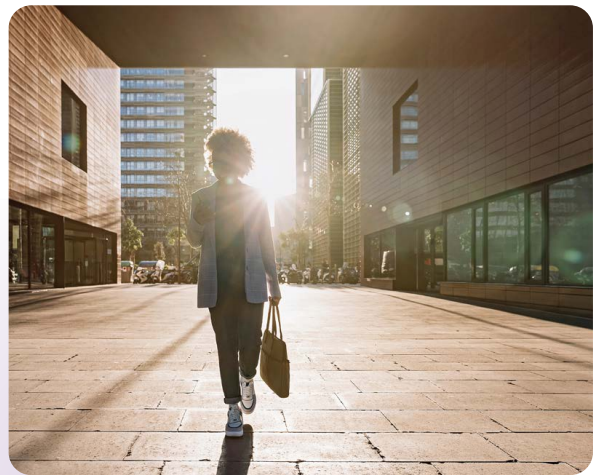

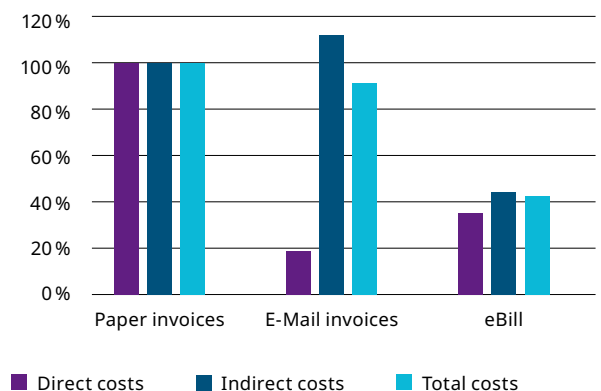


Save Now with ebill

Invoicing is a key process in your business and should be as cost effective as possible. No matter the size of your company, eBill is the most cost-effective invoicing method.

The following model calculation shows the savings potential of eBill. Based on the cost of a paper invoice (100 %), the total cost of an eBill invoice is only 42 %. Switching to eBill can therefore save 58 % of the total costs. The total cost is also almost halved compared to sending invoices by e-mail. Switching to eBill is not only worthwhile financially: you and your customers also benefit from the high security standards of the Swiss financial center.

Switching to eBill Pays Off for You and Your Customers

The results of the model calculation are also in line with the experience of the Swiss Federal Railways (SBB), which introduced eBill in 2020 and is reaping the benefits. According to SBB, it saves around thirty centimes per eBill compared to a paper invoice (PAY Magazine, 2023, pp. 10-11). There are also fewer corrections and less manual support.

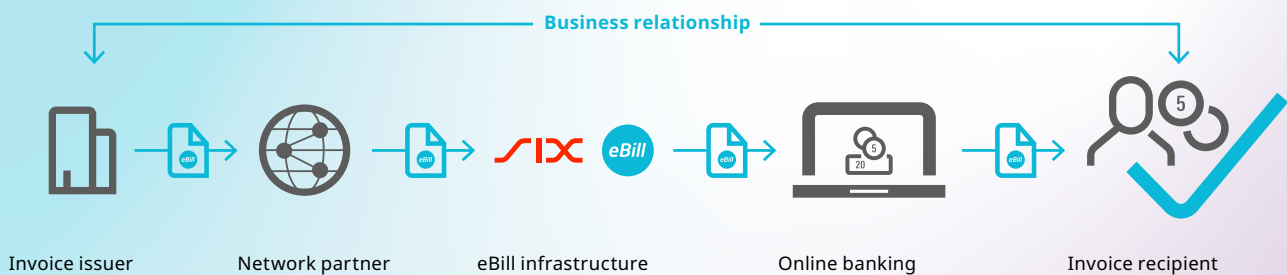
The data also shows that with eBill, your customers are more likely to pay their invoices on time. This saves companies the cost of dunning and overdue notices. Digital invoicing also significantly reduces

paper consumption, conserving natural resources and protecting the environment.
